With the Spirit at our side, and mindful of the Blessed Mother, we follow God's will and the teachings of Jesus Christ, especially through Sunday Worship and the care of parishioners for one another and by connecting life and faith on a regular basis.



### Parish Outreach

- Parish contributions to Service and Outreach totaled \$18,685.
- Advent Giving Tree served 38 families
- CRS Rice Bowl Collection - \$784.

Individual organizations also contributed to and served the poor and vulnerable. Among these were:

- Daughters of Isabella – raised \$2,685 for charities including Peace Pantry, St. Vincent de Paul, Women in Transition, Birthright, and more.
- The OLQP Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul - distributed \$15,242 to 133 families in need.
- St. Vincent de Paul Youth – raised and distributed \$7,689 to Project Plus, Homeless Youth Initiative, Back-to-School Fair, Giving Tree and the OLQP St. Vincent de Paul Society Conference.
- Hope Builders – raised about \$3,000 and served 6 families in need of home repairs and maintenance.
