

# 2015 Commitment Report

During the 2015 Stewardship Campaign, an effort was made to simplify the process of annually renewing memberships in parish organizations, activities and committees. All organization heads were asked to review and revise rosters of active members and submit these to us. From the revised lists, we completed a renewal of all active members. We published and asked parishioners to review these revised organization rosters. In the end, there were three reasons for individual parishioners to submit a personal commitment card:

1. They were active in an organization and not listed on the roster
2. They were listed on a roster for an organization in which they no longer wished to participate
3. They wanted to sign up to participate in a new organization or activity

27 people made 72 personal commitments to renew or establish participation in organizations and activities. Organizational renewals were made for 355 parishioners. These individuals participate in a total of 677 organizations and activities. This gives a total of 382 people, or 16.9% of the total population of the parish who are actively involved in parish life beyond Sunday attendance.

In the recent viability study, it was noted that an indicator of parish viability is a 10% rate of participation in parish activities determined by the number of those who regularly attend Sunday liturgy. Recent counts show that we average between 600 and 700 parishioners at Sunday liturgy each weekend. This would indicate that, among active parishioners, we average approximately 54.5% participation in parish activities and organizations over and above participation in the Sunday celebration of the Eucharist.
