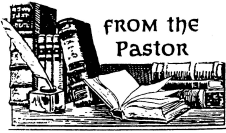

- The 6th graders are working hard on their production of the Passion Play?



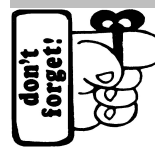
