ABSOLUTELY INCREDIBLE!!!! Quite honestly, I was extremely stressed out last week worrying about the Parish Picnic. I was afraid that it could have turned out to be a complete fiasco- -would anyone show up? Would everyone's prayers for good weather be heard? - - - but what a great event it turned out to be. There are so many people to thank for all the work that went into to re-vitalizing the Picnic that there is no way I could list everyone in one simple column: Set-up, clean-up, games, prizes, the kitchen, dining room, advertising, the raffles, and on and on and on. But a big thank you to Jane Saggio our chairman, Renee Heibeck who oversaw booths and volunteers, Al Schuld who oversaw the raffles, Scott Bunse who put together the rides, and as I said, the list could go on and on and on. This picnic, and hopefully others like it in the future, are what your children and grandchildren will tell stories about in the future, "Remember the picnics we used to have at OLQP when we were kids?"

It will probably be at least a couple of weeks before we have all of the bills in, but as of right now I can tell you that we grossed about \$36,000 and that we could clear about \$20,000 to \$23,000 we think.

By the time you are reading this bulletin, the Parish Offices will have moved (I think) to the former Convent, former Parish Activities Center, now the Parish House for offices. Phone numbers remain the same, the parish address will remain the same, but this move gives our staff more space for getting their work done and, it creates the space we need in the Rectory for a 3rd priest to move in come July. The Rectory is now a residence only for the priests with the exception of the meeting room on the lower level. Hopefully we will have Fr. Don's rooms finished soon so that we can host Bishop Hermann for dinner before Confirmation on May 13th.
