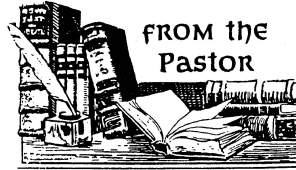

- More than half the blood needed nationwide every day is Type O.
- Any patient can receive Type O negative blood.
- O positive blood comprises 36% of the population, yet it can be transfused to over 80% of all patients.
- About 6% of the population has O negative blood. Any patient can receive this blood type, making it crucial in emergency situations when there is not enough time to determine a patient's blood type.
- O negative patients can receive only O negative blood.
- Shortages of all blood types traditionally occur during the summer and winter holidays.
- On any given day, an average of 34,000 units of red blood cells are needed for patients in the U.S. More than 23 million units of blood components are used each year to help save lives.
