The readings for next Sunday, June 15, are:

- First Reading..... Exodus 19:2-6
- Second Reading ..... Romans 5, 6-11
- Gospel ..... Matthew 9:36 - 10:8

In today's Gospel Jesus sends his disciples out and tells them how to act as his messengers. Jesus' response to the crowds in need of shepherding is to authorize his disciples to extend his own healing. Although here they are told not to preach to non-Jews, later in Matthew's Gospel Jesus will commission his disciples to "go and make disciples of all nations" (28:19). But this will not take place until after the Resurrection. In these early sections of the Gospel, the emphasis is on healing rather than teaching.

**Life Focus:** Speak of a time when it became to you that you could make a difference to another. How did you do it?

**STEWARDSHIP**

*"Let us know, let us strive to know the Lord: as certain as the dawn in his coming."* (Hosea 6:3)

Just as in the Parable of the talents, our God is the owner of everything. He is the master who has entrusted many gifts to us. Someday He will return and ask, "What did you do with the gifts I gave you?" Will He be pleased with our report? Will we hear His invitation to lasting joy, "Well done, my good and faithful servant...Come, share your master's joy." (Matthew 25:21)

**Financial Corner**

As a heads up for the parish it is the belief of this committee that we will end this fiscal year (ending June 30, 2008) with a deficit of nearly \$135,000. We have over \$74,000 in past due accounts from parish families, from tuition to after school care and the like. This past due amount and how much gets collected between now and the end of June will have a direct effect on what the final deficit amount is. If you owe the parish any of this past due amount please help us. It is for this reason that we ask all to reflect on what each of you is able to do to wipe our or reduce this deficit. Frequently Asked Questions**

**Who can donate?** Healthy individuals who are over 18, weigh at least 110 pounds and are not taking antibiotics or insulin. Seventeen year olds can donate with parental consent.


**How often can I donate?** Every 56 days or six times a year.

**Can I contract a disease by donating blood?** No. The needles are new and sterile; they're used once and then thrown away.

**Does giving blood make you weak?** The average adult has 10 to 12 pints of blood flowing through their body. When you donate blood, only one pint is taken, and that amount is easily replenished by your body.

**Doesn't most of the blood just get thrown away?** Procedures have been implemented to ensure that your donation will not go to waste. Most blood centers do not have a consistent enough supply of blood to meet demand.

**How long can blood be kept?** Forty-two days, which is why continual donations are needed.
